
The Student Life Department offers to our students the opportunity to develop leadership skills by participating in our clubs, households, and Student Government Association (SGA).

POLICY OF CREDITS TRANSFER

Evaluation of Transfer Credits is subject to approval by the Dean of Academics. The courses must be similar in content and duration to those offered in the program for which an applicant has applied. Only courses listed on official transcripts receive permanent official transfer credit.

• A Transfer student must complete the final 25% (2 semester= 30 credits) of a program through the University. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale for all college coursework.

• Only courses with a grade of "C" (70+ on a scale of 100) or higher are considered for transfer credit. Courses in a student major must meet the same general course objectives as Keiser University courses.

• Preliminary notification is presented, in most cases prior to enrollment.

• Students are responsible for having official transcripts sent to Keiser University from their former institution(s).

• College philosophies, objectives, and programs may vary and change from year to year. Therefore, Keiser University makes no blanket statement or promise of acceptance of credits from any other institution.

• Students must follow the process of credentializing to determine if their credits are coming from a US-equivalent regionally accredited institution



CREDIT TRANSFER

The following procedure must be followed, prior to the official enrollment to evaluate transcripts received from other accredited institutions.

• No fees are required to submit a request for Evaluation of Transfer Credits.

• Submit an official transcript duly signed and sealed from a former institution. The transcript must be mailed directly to Keiser University by the previous institution.

• Submit official transcript and copy high school diploma.

• Submit Course descriptions duly signed and sealed from a former institution, for those successfully completed courses that parallel course content and duration of Keiser University courses.

• The Dean of Academics makes the final decision on accepted transfer credits from the received transcript.

• Transfer students are informed in writing of any credits accepted as transferable.

• Questions concerning transfer evaluations should be addressed to the Office of the Academic Dean a/o the Office of Academic Advisor.
