- Completed application form.
- Original high school transcripts for the last two years.
- Copy of high school graduation diploma.
- Logic test: Wonderlic.
- Copy of identification.
- Full-face photograph.

Steps to enroll at Keiser University:

- Complete the admission application form and pay the \$50 USD non-refundable application fee.
- Submit all admission documents.
- 3 Complete the Financial Aid Package Application form with all required supporting documentation (if applicable).
- Take the English and Math placement tests (required for English-language programs).
- 5 Accept and sign the payment plan.
- Submit the dormitory application and reservation fee (required for San Marcos campus).
- Pay the first installment or the full semester tuition to receive a 5% discount.
- 8 Register for classes.
- 9 Attend classes.
